Regulations Governing the Hao-hsin Hui Scholarship

Approved at the first Departmental Affairs Council meeting on November 4, 2015

1. Establishment:

To reward outstanding students from the Department of Oceanography (hereinafter “the Department”), National Sun Yat-Sen University, Professor Ping-Jyun Sung established the Hao-hsin Hui Scholarship (hereinafter “the Scholarship) with a prize of NT\$12,000 per year.

2. Recipients:

Undergraduate students from the Department with proactive attitudes and good moral character.

3. Scholarship quota and amount:

The scholarship is provided for one student per year with a prize worth NT\$12,000.

4. Eligibility:

Undergraduates from the Department of Oceanography; candidates from low-income families or with an interest in biological research are prioritized.

5. Application procedure:

Applicants shall provide the following documents for review:

- (1) application form,
- (2) undergraduate transcripts from the National Sun Yat-Sen University or other universities, and
- (3) documents relevant to the applicant’s scholarship review, such as research reports, published papers, and certificates of awards.

6. Application date:

The applicant must submit an application within one month after the academic year begins (in late October every year) and prior to the specified deadline; the date will be announced later.

7. Application review:

Applications shall be reviewed by the Academic Committee of the Department.

8. These regulations become effective upon approval by a Department Affairs Council meeting. Amendments must follow the same procedure.
