1. Promotion based on Specialized Publication

An assistant professor applying for promotion to associate professor must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Publish at least five papers in SCIE journals as “the first author (in addition to the student author)” or “corresponding author” in the recent five years; or publish three to four papers in SCIE journals as the first author or corresponding author, and conduct three or more general research projects of the Ministry of Science and Technology as the principal investigator within five years.
- (2) A representative publication must be published within three years on behalf of National Sun Yat-sen University and must not be an extended piece of the applicant’s dissertation.
- (3) One of the submitted representative or reference publications must be written by the applicant other than the student author mentored by the applicant. The aforementioned student is required to study at National Sun Yat-sen University.

An associate professor applying for promotion to professor must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Publish at least five papers in SCIE journals as “the first author (in addition to the student author)” or “corresponding author” in the recent five years.
- (2) A representative publication must be published within three years on behalf of National Sun Yat-sen University and must not be an extended piece of the applicant’s dissertation.
- (3) One of the representative publications or at least one-third of the reference publications submitted must be written by the applicant other than the student author mentored by the applicant and the postdoctoral research fellow. The aforementioned student and the postdoctoral research fellow are required to study/work at National Sun Yat-sen University.

2. Promotion based on Technical Report (the following two requirements must

be met)

- (1) Receive the Outstanding Teaching Award (in the industry-academia research category) or Excellence in Industry-Academia Research Award of National Sun Yat-sen University; or at least score 24 points for research project subsidies and other relevant achievements specified in A2 of Faculty (Assistant Professor or Higher) Promotion Scoring Form (Final Review): Technical Application of National Sun Yat-sen University within seven years at the current rank.
- (2) R&D outcomes of the representative technical report shall be presented on behalf of National Sun Yat-sen University within three years.

3. Promotion based on Teaching Research Publication (the following three requirements must be met)

- (1) Publish at least three papers in SCIE journals as “the first author (in addition to the student author)” or “corresponding author” in the recent five years; or publish two papers in SCIE journals as the first author or corresponding author, and conduct two or more general research projects of the Ministry of Science and Technology as the principal investigator within five years.
- (2) Receive the Outstanding Teaching Award (in the teaching category) or Excellence in Teaching Award of National Sun Yat-sen University; or nominated by the College of Engineering for Excellence in Teaching Award of National Sun Yat-sen University at least twice at the current rank.
- (3) The applicant shall be “the first author (in addition to the student author)” or “corresponding author” of the representative teaching research publication which shall be presented on behalf of National Sun Yat-sen University within three years. The aforementioned student is required to study at National Sun Yat-sen University.

- Score at least 24 points for research project subsidies and other relevant achievements specified in A2 of "Faculty (Assistant Professor or Higher) Promotion Scoring Form (Final Review): Technical Application of National Sun Yat-sen University" within seven years at the current rank. **【The scoring form reviewed and approved by the unit in charge is attached.】**
- R&D outcomes of the representative technical report shall be presented on behalf of National Sun Yat-sen University within three years. **【Supporting documents are attached.】**

(3) Promotion based on Teaching Research Publication

- Publish at least three papers in SCIE journals as "the first author (in addition to the student author)" or "corresponding author" in the recent five years; or publish two papers in SCIE journals as the first author or corresponding author, and conduct two or more general research projects of the Ministry of Science and Technology as the principal investigator within five years. **【Supporting documents are attached.】**
- Receive the Outstanding Teaching Award (in the teaching category) of National Sun Yat-sen University at the current rank. **【Supporting documents are attached.】**
- Receive the Excellence in Teaching Award of National Sun Yat-sen University at the current rank. **【Supporting documents are attached.】**

- Nominated by the College of Engineering for Excellence in Teaching Award of National Sun Yat-sen University at least twice at the current rank. 【Supporting documents are attached.】
