- Article 1. The Department of Business Management, National Sun Yat-sen University (hereinafter referred to as the Department) established the Guidelines for Faculty Evaluation (hereinafter referred to as the Guidelines) based on the "National Sun Yat-sen University Guidelines for Faculty Evaluation" in order to improve the quality of teaching, researches, counseling and services of the teachers in the Department.
- Article 2. The evaluation items methods, criteria, and procedures shall be conducted in accordance with the Faculty Evaluation Regulations of the University and the relevant regulations of the College of Management

 Items and scoring for faculty evaluations follow the details stated in the "College of College Regulations for Evaluation Standards" and "National Sun Yat-sen University Faculty Evaluation Indicators".(As the attachment) The proportions of the three items—teaching, research, and service performances—within standards are as follows: teaching (the assistant professors and above) accounts for 40%, research accounted for 30%, and service accounts for 30%, of the total 100%.
- Article 3. The Guidelines shall be implemented after being reviewed and approved by the department affairs meeting, the academic affairs meeting, and the faculty evaluation committee of the University. The same procedure shall apply when amendments are to be made.
