1. These Directions are issued for the appointment of full-time and part-time faculty members of the Department of Political Economy (hereinafter referred to as the “Department”). All directions are enacted in accordance with the *Regulations for the Establishment of the Faculty Evaluation Committee*, *Regulations for Appointment Qualifications of Faculty and Researchers*, and *Directions for the Examination of Appointment Qualifications for the Part-Time Faculty* at National Sun Yat-sen University (hereinafter the “University”).
2. The appointment of faculty members of the Department shall be handled in accordance with these directions, unless otherwise stipulated by law.
3. The appointment qualifications of faculty members at all levels of the Department shall meet with Article 3 of the *Regulations for Appointment Qualifications of Faculty and Researchers* at the University.
4. The appointment procedures for new full-time faculty members at the Department shall be executed in accordance with the *Regulations for Appointment Qualifications of Faculty and Researchers* of the University—with the approval of the preliminary review by the Faculty Evaluation Committee of the Department, it shall be resubmitted to the Faculty Evaluation Committee of the Social Science College for a secondary review. Following the approval of the secondary review,

the Faculty Evaluation Committee of the University shall take the appointment procedure for final review. Newly appointed faculty members, except for those who are exempted from an external review of publications under the *Regulations for Appointment Qualifications of Faculty and Researchers* of the University, should apply for external review of their academic publications (including degree theses) or technical reports made after their previous rank of professorship. The maximum number of submissions for review will be up to 10 pieces. The candidate faculty members shall select one publication or report as the representative work and list the others as references. Serial publications of a single research project can be submitted as a single representative work. The procedures for external review of the publications are in accordance with *Regulations for Appointment Qualifications of Faculty and Researchers* of the University.

5. The appointment procedures for new part-time faculty members at the Department are in accordance with the *Directions for the Examination of Appointment Qualifications for the Part-Time Faculty* of the University.
6. Regarding the initial appointment, renewal, termination, suspension, non-renewal, and other related matters of faculty members, as well as matters unaddressed in these Directions shall be conducted in accordance with *Regulations for Appointment Qualifications of Faculty and Researchers* and other applicable regulations of the University.
7. This set of directions shall be implemented following the approval of the Department General Meeting, the review and approval of the College Faculty Evaluation Committee, and the authorization of the president of the University. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
