Regulations of Encouraging Students to Participate in English Proficiency Testing

Approved by the 3th Joint Department and Institute General Meeting on October 23, 2009, School Year 98.
Amended and approved by the Department and Institute Scholarship Meeting on November 03, 2010, School Year 99.
Amended and Approved by the 3th Joint Department and Institute General Meeting on November 26, 2010, School Year 99.

- Article 1: “Regulations of Encouraging Students to Participate in English Proficiency Testing” (hereafter referred to as “the regulations”) are set to strengthen English proficiency of students in the Institute of Communications Engineering.
- Article 2: The regulations are applicable to the master students of the Institute who take the off-campus English proficiency test (including GEPT, FLPT, CSEPT, Cambridge Main Suite, BULATS, TOEIC, TOEFL, and IELTS). The institute will subsidize half of the registration fee required for the test. Students who apply for the subsidy should submit the subsidy application with the original receipt of the registration fee and the proof of passing the test to the institute within the year.
- Article 3: The funding source of the regulations is the relevant funds of the Institute. Each student can apply twice only during his/her study period of the Institute.
- Article 4: The present regulations shall be implemented following the approval of joint department and institute general meeting, as well as the authorization of the president. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
