

# **Establishment Regulations for the Curriculum Committee of Si Wan College at National Sun Yat-Sen University**

Amended and approved by the 137<sup>th</sup> Academic Affairs administrative meeting on October 14, 2013.  
Amended and approved by the 151<sup>th</sup> Academic Affairs administrative meeting on March 16, 2017.  
Amended and approved by the 160<sup>th</sup> Academic Affairs administrative meeting on May 20, 2019.

Article 1. To carry out curriculum review and other related affairs of general and interdisciplinary education, the Curriculum Committee of Si Wan College at National Sun Yat-Sen University (hereafter referred to as the Curriculum Committee) is established in accordance with the provisions of “National Sun Yat-Sen University Curriculum Committee Establishment Guidelines” and “Foundation Act of Si Wan College at National Sun Yat-sen University”.

Article 2. All resolutions made by the Curriculum Committee shall be submitted and reviewed by the University Curriculum Committee and the Academic Affairs Meeting.

Article 3. The Curriculum Committee is composed of the Dean and Associate Dean of Si Wan College, Directors of the Centers, one teacher representative from each center at Si Wan College, teacher representative of Si Wan College at the University Curriculum Committee, one teacher representative from each college (must be members of the University Curriculum Committee), one or two student representatives, and one or two experts or scholars from outside the university (including industry representatives). The Dean of Si Wan College shall act as the convener.

Article 4. The service term of the members of the Curriculum Committee shall be two years and can be re-elected. Two meetings shall be convened every semester, and extraordinary meetings can be convened by the Dean if required.

Article 5. Duties of the Curriculum Committee:

- (1) Review the structure and direction of development of the curriculum planned by the curriculum committees of the centers at Si Wan

College;

- (2) Integrate and coordinate course proposals of the centers to avoid repetition or waste of resources;
- (3) Review and check the new courses of each center;
- (4) Review the applicable structure of general education courses and other related matters for new students;
- (5) Review other curriculum-related matters.

Article 6. The matters that are not covered by the Establishment Guidelines shall be subject to the related laws and regulations.

Article 7. The Establishment Regulations were approved by the Curriculum Committee of Si Wan College, and implemented after being approved by the University Curriculum Committee. The same procedure is applicable to the amendment of the Regulations.
