Regulations for Competition Participation Reward

Established at the Department General Meeting on November 15, 2013

Amended at the Department General Meeting on November 16, 2016

1. The Regulations for Competition Participation Reward (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) is applicable to students of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering (hereinafter referred to as “the Department”) who participate in sporting competitions or competitions related to computer science and engineering at the international, national, or regional level and finish in the top places in the final round during their studies at National Sun Yat-sen University (hereinafter referred to as “NSYSU”) on behalf of the Department.

Competitions do not include friendly competitions. The final round refers to the last stage of a competition.

2. For students who participate in the competition as a team, the team will be regarded as a rewarded unit. If the competition is related to research paper presentation, the applicant must be the first author, single author, or corresponding author and only one student per paper will be rewarded.

3. The chairman decides the reward amount based on the annual budget. The maximum amount for each place in a competition is listed as follows:

4. Application and Approval Procedures: The winner (winning team) fills out the application form and submits it with supporting documents and the signature of the faculty member involved from the Department (the advisor or homeroom teacher) during the period between the end of the competition and the start of the following semester. The application will be approved by the chairman. If the application is not made by the assigned period, the winner forfeits the right to receive a reward.
5. The advisor or homeroom teacher shall advise on the reward to be applied at the university level. The office of the Department shall support the applicant to complete relevant application and administrative processes.
6. The Regulations become effective after being approved at the Department General Meeting. Amendments to the Regulations shall follow the same procedure.
