## **NSYSU Tennis Court Management Regulations**

History of Amendment and Approval: 3<sup>rd</sup> Student Affairs Division Meeting of 2020-Academic Year on 31-03-2009

- Article 1 These regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) are formulated to effectively manage the NSYSU Tennis Court (hereinafter referred to as the Court), to ensure venue management efficiency, and to maintain the interest of users.
- Article 2 The opening hours of the Court are as announced by the University. No entry is permitted during the closed hours without prior authorization. Trespassers shall be prosecuted.
- Article 3 Individuals shall be admitted through the presentation of the valid NSYSU Sport Card or iPass payment per admission. The charging standard shall be processed in accordance to the NSYSU Charging Standard for Personal Usage of Sports Venues.
- Article 4 The priority to use the Court is in accordance to the NSYSU Sports Venue Management Regulations:
  - 1. Large events organized or implemented by the University
  - 2. Events which completed the booking procedure and are approved by the President
  - 3. Physical education courses of the University
  - 4. Training sessions of representative sporting teams
  - 5. Events hosted by internal units (students/staff/employees)
- Article 5 To maintain the hygiene of the Court and other users' interests, users are not allowed to drink from water dispensers directly with their mouths. No food and drinks except water is permitted on the outside court. The users should take their trash with them when they leave, and dispose the trash into trash cans or recycling bins.
- Article 6 Pets are not allowed in the Court.
- Article 7 The users should be responsible for the safekeeping of their personal belongings. The Court should not be in liable any circumstances for any damage or loss of personal belongings.
- Article 8 Hang drying clothes in the washrooms or occupying lockers is not allowed without prior application and authorization. Should the management unit find such cases, the unit shall have the authority to dispose of all property found therein, and shall not be liable for any loss or damage.
- Article 9 Drinking is strictly prohibited on the premises of the Court (both inside and outside). No cooking is permitted.
- Article 10 Unauthorized training classes not hosted by the University and private training activities are not allowed.
- Article 11 The management procedures shall be executed by the management staff according to the Regulations. Violators who are not willing to abide by the Regulations after being advised by the management staff shall be evicted from the Court. If necessary, the management unit shall seek assistance from the police. The admission fee shall not be returned to those evicted from the Court. Severe cases of violations shall be deprived of the right to use the Court in accordance to the NSYSU Sports Venue Management Regulations.
- Article 12 These regulations should be practiced after being passed by the Student Affairs Division Meeting. The same procedure applies for future amendments.
