

# NSYSU Guidelines on Sports Awards and Subsidies

Article 1 These guidelines (hereinafter referred to as the Guidelines) are formulated to cultivate students' athletic potential, promote positive concepts of sports and bodybuilding, and encourage participation in sports competitions and exchanges inside and outside of the University.

## Article 2 Inter-departmental Championships

1. Principles of Participation: One team is allowed for each department or institute. Should a representative merged team of a department and an institute apply for the championships, the scores shall be accumulated on the part of the department. The scores shall be accumulated individually for individual teams.
2. Scoring Events:
  - a) Inter-departmental Championships
  - b) Games in the NSYSU Sports Day (according to the regulation of the games)
3. Number of participating teams
  - a) Inter-departmental Championships
    - i) Men's Division: 10 or more teams (inclusive)
    - ii) Women's Division: 6 or more teams (inclusive)
    - iii) General Division: 10 or more teams (inclusive)
  - b) Games in the NSYSU Sports Day: According to the regulation of the games
4. Awards and Score Point Allocation
  - a) Score Point Allocation: The top three in each division, 7 points for the 1<sup>st</sup> place, 5 points for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 4 points for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
  - b) Awards:
    - i) Winners in the top three of the Inter-departmental Championships shall be conferred: NTD 8,000 scholarship and one trophy for the 1<sup>st</sup> place; NTD 5,000 and one trophy for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place; and NTD 2,000 and one trophy for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
    - ii) The total award shall be calculated through the accumulated scores of the department or institute in the Inter-departmental Championships and in Games in the NSYSU Sports Day for the academic year. Scholarships and trophies shall be conferred to teams in the top three: NTD 80,000 scholarship and one trophy for the 1<sup>st</sup> place; NTD 50,000 and one trophy for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place; and NTD 20,000 and one trophy for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

### Article 3 Extramural Games

#### 1. Principles of Subsidy:

- a) Subsidy shall be granted to teams in the preliminary round of the Intercollegiate Sports Tournaments. Teams achieving the top three of the division in the preliminary round may be receive subsidies for the next rounds.
- b) Teams participating in National Intercollegiate Athletic Games, or championships held by the Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation or other national sports associations are eligible for subsidy with one of the following qualifications:
  - i) Entering the top 8 in the division or entering semi-finals in the game of the year.
  - ii) Entering the top 3 in the district game or in the group of a similar tier.
  - iii) Showing outstanding performance in team training and recognized by the coach.

The proposal for the subsidy may be submitted to the Sport Development Division Meeting separately.

Teams not having the aforementioned qualifications shall only receive subsidy covering the registration fee (under other relevant funds).

- c) Regional games: Participation in regional games shall be filed at the Sport Development Division for approval; each team may only receive subsidy once per semester upon approval by the Sport Development Division.
- #### 2. Target team and number of members covered by subsidy: the representative sporting teams of the University are the target teams of the subsidy; the number of members covered by subsidy shall depend on the nature of the sport game.
- #### 3. Standards of subsidy:
- a) National Intercollegiate Athletic Games, Intercollegiate Sports Tournaments, or championships held by the Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation:
    - i) Should the location of the game be in Tainan or northern parts of Taiwan (inclusive), or be in a distance beyond 60 km from the University and be in need of accommodation, NTD 1,000 shall be granted to each member per day for subsidy. NTD 250 shall be granted for the expenses on the day of the return. For games with locations not beyond 60 km from the University, NTD 250 shall be granted for the expenses per member per day.
    - ii) The subsidy for travel fares shall be granted according to the standard fare of the Chu-Kuang Express train.
  - b) Regional games: NTD 3,000 subsidy shall be granted to each eligible team per semester.

Article 4 Part-time job payment for Inter-departmental championships: Within the budget allowance, the representative sporting team hosting the inter-departmental championships may receive part-time payment according to the hours of the game

Article 5 The subsidy may only be used to support teams participating in competitions, no other use

is allowed.

Article 6 The subsidies for sports competitions are under the funding of the University; the sum of the subsidies may be adjusted in proportion to the annual funding.

Article 7 The Regulations should be implemented after being discussed by the Student Affairs Division Meeting, passed by the University Administration Council Meeting, and approved by the NSYSU President. The same procedure applies in cases of amendments.
