

NSYSU Representative Sporting Team Evaluation Measures

Article 1 These measures (hereinafter referred to as the Measures) are formulated to enforce regular trainings of representative sporting teams, encourage outstanding team performance, and cultivate students' proactiveness and responsibility.

Article 2 The Measures are devised in accordance to the NSYSU Representative Sporting Team Guidance and Management Measures.

Article 3 Evaluation Committee:

The evaluation committee should be convened by the Sport Development Division and comprise the director of the Sport Development Division and 5-7 representative sporting team coaches.

Article 4 Evaluation Procedure:

The evaluation shall be executed once per academic year. The representative sporting teams should prepare and submit the relevant information, statements and records to the Sport Development Division before the end of June. The documents shall be compiled by the person in charge and sent to the evaluation committee for evaluation.

Article 5 The evaluation criteria is based on Team Training Performance, Competition Participation Performance, and Sports Activity Performance.

1. The Team Training Performance takes up 60 score points (point deduction by ratio), the standards is as follows:

(1) Meeting attendance (15 score points): Score points shall be deducted by the ratio of the number of absences to the total number of meetings of the academic year.

(2) Report compilation being complete and in time (15 score points): Score points shall be deducted by the ratio of the number of missing reports to the total number of reports that should be submitted in the academic year. One score point shall be deducted for each late submission.

(3) Regular training (20 score points): Score points shall be deducted by the attendance and random monitoring staff record from the Sport Development Division to full attendance.

(4) Use of facilities/venues (10 score points): Should the representative sporting team leave the facility without cleaning up or informing the management staff to turn off the lights, or be observed to use the equipment without proper care, one score point shall be deducted for each incident.

2. The Competition Participation Performance takes up 30 score points (point attribution by event), the standards for the allocation of score points can be found in the appendix. The explanation of the criteria is as follows:

(1) Team events shall be divided into National Games, Tournaments, and Friendly Matches. Three score points shall be attributed for every participation in competitions. Regarding the outcomes of the competitions, score points shall be allocated according to the place won in National Games, or according to the ratio of the place won to the number of total participating teams in other competitions.

- (2) Individual events shall be divided into National Games, Tournaments, and Friendly Matches. For each participation in competitions, 0.5 score points shall be attributed (0.25 score points for Friendly Matches); 3 points may be attributed to each competition at most. Regarding the outcomes of the competitions, score points shall be allocated according to the place won in National Games, or according to the ratio of the place won to the number of total participating teams in other competitions.
 - (3) Intercollegiate leagues: Three basic score points shall be attributed for participating in intercollegiate leagues. Should the team enter semifinals, an additional 2 score points shall be attributed. Should the team enter semifinals, an additional 2 score points shall be attributed. Regarding the outcomes of the competitions, score points shall be allocated according to the place won. If the league only has two divisions (e.g. Open Division and General Division), score points shall only be allocated to the top 8 places won.
 - (4) CHCW Cup: Score points shall be allocated according to the place won. No score points shall be allocated if the ranking won is the same as the number of participating schools.
3. The Sports Activity Performance takes up 30 score points (point attribution by event). Two score points shall be attributed to each incident in which the team organizes or hosts competitions in the University, organizes or hosts intercollegiate competitions, conducts sports performances, and organizes sports promotion activities.

Article 6 Special score point attribution/deduction: should the representative sporting team be involved in any incidents of exceptional performance or severe misconduct, the evaluation committee may discuss and attribute or deduct 1 to 5 extra score points.

Article 7 Commendations and Sanctions

1. For representative sporting teams attaining more than 85 score points and be in the top three of the teams evaluated, the Sport Development Division shall confer the NSYSU one-year Sport Card as a reward to all team members who have been on the team for over one year. The team may also have the priority in using the venues and facilities managed by the Sport Development Division; the relevant venues and open time shall be devised separately.
2. For representative sporting teams evaluated with lower than 75 score points, the teams shall be listed as probation teams. The team trainings may be terminated with the resolution from over 50% of the team members.
3. Funding subsidies shall be rationally deducted for probation teams (the team may receive 80% of the subsidies at most). Shall the team fail to attain 70 score points in the next evaluation, the formation of the representative sporting team shall be revoked.
4. The team revoked or with team trainings terminated shall return the equipment and properties of the Sport Development Division. Representative sporting teams with a similar nature shall not be formed within one year.
5. Any representative sporting teams with fewer than 3 team members may be dissolved upon discussion of the evaluation committee regardless of the score points.

Article 8 The Measures is implemented upon approval by the Student Affairs Division Meeting. The same procedure applies in cases of amendments.

Individual events: Doubles sports included

Intercollegiate Leagues: Basketball, volleyball, soccer, and baseball leagues only.

National Games: National Intercollegiate Athletic Games, College Championships, or championships held by the Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation or other national sports associations.

Tournaments: Tournaments or championships not listed as National Games, or tournaments with participants from educational levels other than the university level.

Friendly Matches: College sports exchange games hosted by each university.
